This unique 11" teapot is:

- Hand-built out of porcelain clay slabs
- Impressed with various surface textures
- Colored with oxide stains and glazes
- Fired in an electric kiln to 2232° F

### Bowl **Karen Machleit**

This functional and earthy 9" diameter bowl is:

- Wheel-thrown, using orange stoneware
- Unglazed rim with cutout detail
- Bowl surface is glazed with a green (wood) ash glaze
- Fired in a gas reduction kiln to approx 2400° F

This 3-footed 8" tall vase is:

- Wheel-thrown round and pushed oval, using high fire stoneware
- Decorated with two lugs on either side of the oval opening
- Glazed with a Tenmoku glaze
- Fired in a gas reduction kiln to approx. 2400° F

- Wheel-thrown, using high fire stoneware
- Impressed with a facial feature design
- Glazed with a Shino glaze
- Fired in a gas reduction kiln to approx. 2400° F
